TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF DOUBLED WALLED POLYETHYLENE (DWP) DRAINAGE PIPE STANDING OFFER RFQ #4632

1. Scope:

This tender is for the supply of Doubled Walled Polyethylene Drainage pipe, both Pipe and Couplers and for Bell and Spigot style pipe.

This is a Joint Procurement led by The Province of Prince Edward Island, issued on behalf of the following organizations:

- Prince Edward Island Department of Transportation, Infrastructure and Energy (TIE)
- Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal (TIR)

For the purpose of this tender, "Department" shall refer to the each and/or both of the organizations listed above and "Supplier" shall refer to the awarded bidder.

It is the intent to award this standing offer to a single Supplier for both provinces based on the lowest overall bid.

2. Material (Specifications)

a) Minimum Requirements:

Heavy Duty - Dual Wall - Smooth -walled interior / Corrugated Exterior 6 metre Lengths unless otherwise specified

b) Minimum Rigidity:

375mm to 900mm

- 320 kPa or higher
- Meet and/or Conforms to C S A Standards
- Meet and/or Conforms to AASHTO Standards

1200 mm

- 125 kPa or higher
- Meet and/or Conforms to AASHTO Standards

1500 mm

- 90 kPa or higher
- Meet and/or Conforms to AASHTO Standards

3. Delivery:

All pipes must be delivered on flat beds that can be unloaded from the side with a forklift. The Department will not accept pipe delivered in enclosed trailers.

Pipe will only be accepted between the hours of 7:00 am and 3:00 pm; Monday to Friday excluding holidays. The Department requires 24 hour notice prior to delivery to schedule personnel and equipment for unloading. Delivery shall be FOB Destination, 7 to 10 days from date of issuance of Purchase Order.

Any and all extra costs that are incurred by the Department due to non-compliance may be charged back or deducted from invoices to the Supplier. If the Department purchases pipe from an alternate source due to delivery shortfalls including, but not limited to, material and/or size not being delivered, all extra costs associated with this will be at the Supplier's expense.

Repeated performance issues, including delivery delays beyond the agreed upon delivery time may lead to termination of the standing offer.

Telephone Contacts:

- The Department will provide the successful bidder with a telephone contact number for each delivery point of the contract.
- The successful bidder must provide the Department with a valid company representative contact number, available for the duration of the contract. This representative (or their delegate) must be available through regular working hours for delivery coordination.

4. Special terms and Conditions:

4.1 Contract Term

The term of this contract will be for a term of approximately one (1) year May 15, 2017 to March 31, 2018. Prices to remain in effect for the duration of the tender: with a possible two (2) by one (1) year extensions – the first option being April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019 and the second option being April 1, 2019 to March 31, 2020. The renewal options are at the sole discretion of the Department, and upon mutual agreement with the successful bidder. The Department may negotiate pricing at the time of extension offer, or may choose to retender at its sole discretion.

4.2 Basis of Payment

All prices quoted FOB for various TIE/TIR sites in each Province as noted in their tender package and may include sites other than those listed with approximates, Province wide.

4.3 Order Quantities

Quantities stated are approximate and estimates only, for a one (1) year period, made in good faith. The Department reserves the right to increase or decrease these quantities. The Department's actual quantity requirements will be ordered on an as needed basis, and may vary considerably. Additional delivery sites may be included. The successful bidder will be responsible for maintaining sufficient stock to ensure deliveries as requested, and as promised.

4.4 Award

Prior to award of this RFQ, Standing Offer, the Department may require one or more of the bidders to provide samples for testing and evaluation.

4.6 Subcontracting

4.7 Procurement Lead, Vendor Questions, Addenda

The Province of Prince Edward Island will lead the procurement process. The contact listed on the PEIRFQ Form will act as the sole and official contact for all inquiries pertaining to this Request for Quotations during the tendering period. Only written questions by e-mail will be considered as official and responded to by the contact person listed on the PEIRFQ Form.

The Province of Prince Edward Island will act as the primary contact for general administration of the resulting standing offer, while each organization will establish its framework for placing and managing their own orders.

Notification of award will be made by Procurement Services, The Province of Prince Edward Island. Tender award will be based on evaluation results and pending required approvals. The successful vendor will be posted on The Province of Prince Edward Island tender website, www.gov.pe.ca/tenders and an official award letter will be e-mailed.

Should any one of the participating organizations be delayed or unable to obtain approval for the award due to unforeseen reasons, the other organization reserves the right to proceed with award of its portion of this tender if so desired.
