## APPLICATION CHECKLIST

The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all sections of the application are complete and accurate. **Incomplete applications will not be assessed until all the required information is received. Applications with false, misleading, or inaccurate information may not be considered.** This checklist was developed to help applicants in ensuring that all relevant and accurate information is provided.

The applicant is to provide:

- Documentation demonstrating greater than 30% loss of aquaculture-related revenue in 2025 as a result of MSX and/or Dermo** (for example, buyer slips, income statements, etc.).
- Business information (for example, social insurance number, Revenue Canada business number, DFO Fisher Identification Number - FIN).
- Authorizations to grow oysters, grow oyster seed or collect wild seed (for example, DFO issued lease or license number(s), water lot Property Identification Number(s)) that are currently in your name.
- Notarized, legal sublet or rental agreement(s) for growing oysters, if applicable.
- Documentation demonstrating annual revenue from oyster aquaculture from the last 5 years (for example, T1, T2 tax forms or business' financial statements).
  - If you are unsure of the documents to attach to the application, contact your bookkeeper or accountant (see FAQ document for information).
- Government source (for example, Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency) and payments received in 2023 and/or 2024 for oyster losses due to post-tropical storm Fiona.
- Documentation demonstrating expansion of oyster growing operations (for example, lease reconfiguration, proof of purchase of new lease(s) or added gear).
- Loan information for your oyster aquaculture operation from Finance PEI or other financial institutions.
- Ensure you are registered as a government vendor.
