L-5, Council amended the condition of non-development use made pursuant to section 2 of the Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95) in respect of approximately ninety (90) acres of land, being Provincial Property No. 224204 located at Westmoreland, Lot 29, Queens County, Prince Edward Island and currently owned by Mark Craig Inc. of Albany, Prince Edward Island.

Council noted that this amendment will enable subdivision of a parcel of land of approximately one decimal five (1.5) acres for commercial use, and determined

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that following subdivision, identification for non-development use shall continue to apply to the remaining land.

This Order-in-Council comes into force on August 19, 2025.
