INTERPRETATION ACT

DOG ACT
COMMENCEMENT OF PROCEEDING FORM REGULATIONS
REVOCATION

Pursuant to subsection 10(2) of the *Interpretation Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-8.1, Council made the following regulations:

- 1. The Commencement of Proceeding Form Regulations (EC352/05) made under the *Dog Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. D-13, are revoked.
- 2. These regulations come into force on November 15, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 revokes the Commencement of Proceeding Form Regulations made under the *Dog Act*, which has been repealed. A new Commencement of Proceeding Form is now in the Dog Owners Regulations made under the *Dog Owners Act*.

SECTION 2 provides for the commencement of these regulations.

WILDLIFE CONSERVATION ACT

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS REGULATIONS
AMENDMENT

Pursuant to clause 16(1)(c) of the *Wildlife Conservation Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-4.1, Council made the following regulations:

- 1. **Section 8 of Schedule A to the *Wildlife Conservation Act* Wildlife Management Areas Regulations (EC41/24) is revoked and the following substituted:**
- 8. The following area of land is designated as a wildlife management area:

DESIGNATION

ALL THAT TRACT, piece or parcel of land and water, lying and being at Roseville, in Lot or Township Number 3, Prince County, in the Province of Prince Edward Island, bounded and described as follows:

COMMENCING at the intersection of the shore of the Northumberland Strait and the western boundary of the Kelly Road;

THENCE in a southerly direction following the western boundary of the Kelly Road to the intersection of the northern boundary of Route #14-Lady Slipper Drive,

THENCE in a westerly direction following the northern boundary of Route #14-Lady Slipper Drive, to the southeast corner of PID# 418665;

THENCE following the eastern and northern boundary of PID# 418665 to a point where it intersects the eastern boundary of PID# 716845;

THENCE in a north, west and south direction following the eastern, northern and western boundary of PID# 716845 to a point at the intersection of Route #14-Lady Slipper Drive;

THENCE continuing west along the northern boundary of Route #14-Lady Slipper Drive, to the southwest corner of the Roseville Pond Road;

THENCE in a northerly direction following the western boundary of the Roseville Pond Road to the northeast corner of PID# 1172097;

THENCE in a westerly and northern direction following the northern boundary of PID# 1172097 to a point where it intersects the southwest corner of PID# 605915 and the westerly shore of the Little Miminigash Pond;

THENCE in an easterly direction following the various courses of the Little Miminigash Pond to a point at the southwest corner of PID# 418673;

THENCE north following the western boundary of PID# 418673 to the shore of Northumberland Strait;

THENCE in an easterly direction following the various courses of the Northumberland Strait to the point at the place of commencement.

CONTAINING an area of 154.8 hectares (382.5 acres) of land, a little more or less.

INCLUDING within the Wildlife Management Area the following properties:

EXPLANATORY NOTES
