



CREATING PLACES TO LEARN

New Elementary Schools

\$65.4M over 5 years

To build new elementary schools in East Royalty, West Royalty and Georgetown, addressing capacity needs and providing modern learning environments.



New Summerside School

\$14.5M over 5 years

To support design work beginning in 2028 for a new school, with construction scheduled for 2030.

New and Expanded Intermediate Schools

\$133M over 5 years

To serve fast-growing populations, including \$109M for a new school in Stratford and \$24M to expand Queen Charlotte with more learning spaces for students.

New and Renovated High Schools

\$44M over 5 years

To ensure ample modern educational spaces for the next generation, including \$25M to complete work and open Stratford High School, and \$19M to complete the first phase of renovations on Westisle.



Securing French Language Education

\$92M over 5 years

To support French language education and opportunities in the province, including \$64M to replace Evangeline School in western PEI and \$28M to expand École François Buote in Charlottetown.

School Revitalization and Capital Repairs

\$36M over 5 years

To ensure that aging schools receive the repairs and upgrades they need, including mobile classrooms to provide safe, supportive spaces as immediate relief to classroom pressures.

Childhood Recreation Fund Increase

\$1.5M over 5 years

To help communities create safe, active spaces at schools where Island children can play, move and belong.
