### There were:

- **331** participants in business management training
- **398** participants in market conditions training
- **26** projects with industry associations or other organizations to support sector capacity building



**Over \$2.4 million** invested in PEI's agriculture industry to build sector capacity and economic growth

**1,439 participants** in training events that supported skills development to meet current and future labour requirements
