There were:

- 331 participants in business management training
- 398 participants in market conditions training
- 26 projects with industry associations or other organizations to support sector capacity building



Over \$2.4 million invested in PEI's agriculture industry to build sector capacity and economic growth

1,439 participants in training events that supported skills development to meet current and future labour requirements
