APPLICATION CHECKLIST

The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all sections of the application are complete and accurate. **Incomplete applications will not be assessed until all the required information is received. Applications with false, misleading, or inaccurate information may not be considered.** This checklist was developed to help applicants in ensuring that all relevant and accurate information is provided.

The applicant is to provide:

- Business information (for example, social insurance number, Revenue Canada business number).
- Authorization(s) to process oysters (for example, provincial fish processor license and license from the Canadian Food Inspection Agency, if applicable).
- Documentation demonstrating 2025 oyster purchases and sales (for example, buyer slips).
- Documentation demonstrating oysters in holding at the beginning and end of 2025.
- Ensure you are registered as a government vendor.
