

P.E.I. Intermediate Curriculum Renewal

Over the last four years, several changes have been unfolding for the intermediate level program. In September 2023, these changes will move from pilot phase to implementation across all schools with grades 7 through 9, and focus on key principles including:

- Engaging and relevant curriculum
- Equitable access between programs
- Expanded career exploration
- Increase opportunity for movement
- Fewer transitions during the school day

Updates include:

- Alignment of English and French Immersion programs, particularly language arts with both programs having 30% language arts instruction
- Alternative literacy intervention instruction, if needed
- 60 minute blocks of learning
- Expanded exploratory curriculum, and additional funding
- Engaging exploratory modules focus on developing CAMET competencies of communication, critical thinking, collaboration, citizenship, technological fluency, and personal/career development
- Daily opportunities for students to move during class time
- Transparency with all classes scheduled in the student's timetable

As schools with intermediate grades implement these changes, parents are encouraged to find out more about intermediate curriculum renewal in their child's school.
