

INVESTING IN PEOPLE AND PLACES

Roads, Bridges and Highways

\$296M over 5 years

To maintain reliable infrastructure across the province, ensuring Islanders are kept connected and safe, and keeping our economy moving.



Provincial Collections Storage Facility and Confederation Trail

\$4.9M over 5 years

To support the preservation of human and natural heritage on PEI, and to highlight our heritage along the Confederation Trail.

Protecting our Land

\$21.3M over 5 years

To create safer and more resilient coastal highways and public infrastructure, investments are being made in shoreline protection, buffer zones and potato wart land buybacks, and other land protection acquisitions.

Investment in Housing

\$128M over 5 years

To provide \$28M for upgrades and repairs to existing public housing, and \$100M to build over 300 new affordable public units.

Provincial Parks

\$9M over 5 years

To improve and maintain high quality facilities, such as campsite expansions, to benefit all visitors.

Subsea Power Cable

\$600K over 2 years

To assist early planning for a new subsea power cable, which requires partnership with the federal government, to ensure our energy systems can support community growth.
