This application is for vaccinated individuals to apply for a PEI Pass to be exempt from travel self-isolation requirements on arrival in PEI, and to accept the conditions associated with the use of the PEI Pass. This collection is authorized by the Public Health Act, section 56 and the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, section 31.

Vaccine Information

Note on eligibility: For visitors arriving from outside Atlantic Canada, you must be fully vaccinated to apply for a PEI Pass.

For travellers within Atlantic Canada, including PEI residents, you must be at least 21 days past your first dose of COVID-19 vaccine to be eligible to use your PEI Pass.

Your COVID-19 vaccine must be approved for use in Canada.

- Fully vaccinated (e.g. two doses of an approved vaccine)
- Partially vaccinated (e.g. one dose of an approved vaccine)
- I was vaccinated in Prince Edward Island and consent to a public health official, appointed by the Chief Public Health Officer, verifying my (or minor's) proof of vaccination in the PEI Covid Immunization Registry in relation to my application for a PEI Pass using the information provided.

- I have attached my official vaccine record, issued by a government, a health authority or a licensed health care provider (e.g. pharmacist, physician). *It contains at minimum: the name of the person vaccinated, the date they were vaccinated with one or two doses of a vaccine and the type of vaccine they received.*

I have attached a copy of my government issued photo identification (i.e., driver's license, passport).
For minors aged 12-17, accepted ID includes a license, passport, birth certificate, or provincial health card.

Everyone: Be prepared to provide identification when you reach the PEI point of entry.

I declare the following

(applies to you or any minor person you are applying for):

- I am 18 years of age or older.
- I understand that in order to be eligible for a travel self-isolation exemption with the PEI Pass, I must meet all PEI Pass conditions in place at the time of my entry to the province.
- I understand that if I don't meet the PEI Pass conditions, if I am a PEI resident, I will be required to self-isolate upon entry to PEI, and if I am a non-resident I will have to self-isolate or will not be eligible to enter the province.
- I understand I am not eligible for a travel self-isolation exemption if in the 14 days prior to arriving in PEI, I have been diagnosed with COVID-19, or showed symptoms of COVID-19 and not been tested.
- I understand I am not eligible for a travel self-isolation exemption if in the 14 days prior to arriving in PEI, I have had close contact with a person with active COVID-19 or in self-isolation.
- I will abide by COVID-19 public health orders in PEI, monitor my health closely and go to a drop in testing clinic or contact 811 if I develop symptoms of COVID-19 after arrival.
- I will be tested for COVID-19 at the point of entry as directed.
- I am completing this form on my own behalf (or as the parent or guardian of a minor child) and that the information I have given on this form is complete and correct.
- I understand that it is an offence to knowingly provide false or misleading information, either orally or in writing, to a public health official under the Public Health Act for which I may be ticketed \$1,000 per occurrence.
