ASAP, PEI's youth apprenticeship program, is proud to present this award on behalf of the Provincial Apprenticeship Board, Holland College and industry sponsors.

Award:

- Amount: \$1,000
- The award will be presented to the student at their high school graduation ceremonies for further trades training in Apprenticeship and/or Holland College.
- The award is a bursary/scholarship combination. Half of the award will be in the form of a cheque to the student. The other portion will be awarded as a tuition credit to a Holland College program. The tuition credit is valid for two years after high school graduation.

Criteria:

- You must be registered in the ASAP-youth apprenticeship program.
- You must complete Grade 12 in June;
- You must have accumulated a minimum of 250 hours of paid work experience while registered in ASAP.
- You must plan to continue trades training in Apprenticeship and/or Holland College.

The following must be included with your application form:

- A copy of your high school transcript (unofficial).
- A one page essay (typed/double spaced) describing your experience in ASAP, how ASAP would benefit other students and your future plans for your trades career.
- Your apprenticeship log book which states the hours and skills accumulated while registered in ASAP. These hours and skills must be signed off by your supervisor/employer; and
- A reference letter from your supervisor/employer.
