Vaccine supply is received in PEI between September and throughout October. Please provide your initial order for Influenza vaccine by **September 28, 2018**. Please do not order more vaccine than you can use.

A reminder that according to the *Public Health Act* [Immunization Regulations](#) all immunizers are required to report all immunizations, including influenza to the CPHO. Instructions on reporting will follow prior to vaccine delivery.

If reports were not received for the 2017-18 season we will not be able to provide Influenza vaccine for the 2018-19 season as per the policy and signed agreement.

- Ensuring the appropriate storage and handling of vaccine.
- Not charging the patient/client an administration fee for individuals with a PEI health card
