- 5) I understand that a salesperson may only be licensed as the salesperson of a licensed agent and that the termination of the employment of a salesperson with a licensed agent shall operate as a suspension of the license of that salesperson.
- 6) I will hold out to the public and carry on business in good faith as a real estate salesperson only on behalf of the licensed agent named in Part D of this form.
- 7) I understand that a listing agreement is an agreement between my employing agent and the property owner.
- 8) I understand my license may be revoked at any time if a misstatement has been made in this application.
