CHARLOTTETOWN AREA MUNICIPALITIES ACT
Chapter C-4.1

TRANSITIONAL REGULATIONS (NON-UNIONIZED EMPLOYEES)

Pursuant to section 72 of the *Charlottetown Area Municipalities Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. C-4.1, Council made the following regulations:

1. Definition

In section 4 of Schedule 3 of the *Charlottetown Area Municipalities Act*, “representatives of employees with no union representation” means the persons duly elected by such employees for the purpose of the transitional employment issues referred to in that section. (EC358/95)

2. Employee representatives

The representatives of employees with no union representation shall be the exclusive bargaining agents for such employees for all transitional employment issues referred to in section 4 of Schedule 3 of the Act. (EC358/95)

3. Agreement, authority to execute

- (1) Provided that a majority of the employees with no union representation vote in favour of the agreement, the representatives of such employees may execute an agreement on behalf of all non-unionized employees of the City of Charlottetown on any transitional employment issue referred to in section 4 of Schedule 3 of the Act.

Effect

- (2) An agreement approved and executed in accordance with subsection (1) shall bind all employees and classes of employees of the City of Charlottetown described therein. (EC358/95)
