HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT
Chapter H-5

DESIGNATION OF URBAN AND BUSINESS DISTRICTS REGULATIONS

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5.

1. Urban districts

That section of a highway wherein a maximum speed limit of fifty kilometers per hour is indicated by the erection or existence of a sign at each end of such section of the highway and facing the stream of traffic entering such section of the highway, is designated as an urban district. (*EC225/65; 1039/77*)

2. Business districts

That section of a highway wherein a maximum speed limit of sixty kilometers per hour is indicated by the erection or existence of a sign at each end of the section of the highway and facing the stream of traffic entering the section of the highway is designated as a business district. (*EC225/65; 1039/77*)
