## INTERPROVINCIAL SUBPOENA ACT

### Chapter I-9

## REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 9 of the *Interprovincial Subpoena Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-9, Council made the following regulations:

**1. Witness fees**

For the purposes of the *Interprovincial Subpoena Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-9 the following witness fees are prescribed:

- (a) \$100 per day for an ordinary witness;
- (b) \$300 per day for an expert or professional witness. (EC395/87)

**2. Travelling and living expenses**

For the purposes of the said Act the following travelling and living expenses are prescribed:

Actual, reasonable travelling expenses incurred in relation to attendance in court together with actual, reasonable living expenses, including accommodation, meals, local transport and sundry expenses. (EC395/87)
