ISLANDER DAY ACT CHAPTER I-10.01

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

Current to: May 15, 2009

1. Islander Day

Throughout the Province of Prince Edward Island, the third Monday in February in each year shall be a public holiday, and shall be kept and observed as such under the name of "Islander Day". 2008,c.48,s.1; 2009,c.76,s.1.
