PROVINCIAL BUILDING CODE ACT
Chapter P-24

THERMAL INSULATION REGULATIONS

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Provincial Building Code Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-24

1. Application

This regulation applies to the thermal insulation of all new residential buildings intended for use on a continuing basis. (EC550/76)

2. Insulation requirement for new residential buildings

Thermal insulation of all new residential buildings intended for use on a continuing basis shall be as follows:

- (a) thermal insulation in all ceilings shall have an R value of 20;
- (b) thermal insulation in all walls shall have an R value of 10. (EC550/76)
