RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF JUDGMENTS ACT

Chapter R-6

ORDER

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-6

1. Reciprocating states

The provinces of

Alberta	British Columbia
Manitoba	New Brunswick
Newfoundland & Labrador	Nova Scotia
Ontario	Saskatchewan

are reciprocating states for the purposes of the *Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act*. (EC846/78)

2. *Idem*

The territories known as the Yukon Territory and the Northwest Territories are declared to be reciprocating states for the purposes of the *Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act*. (EC412/88)

3. *Idem*

The state of Washington in the United States of America is declared to be a reciprocating state for the purposes of the said Act. (EC845/90)

4. *Idem*

The territory of Canada to be known as Nunavut is declared to be a reciprocating state for the purposes of the said Act. (EC767/98)
