REGULATED HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT

Chapter R-10.1

EXEMPTION REGULATIONS

Pursuant to subsection 96(1) of the *Regulated Health Professions Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-10.1, Council made the following regulations:

1. Exemption

A person who

- (a) is not registered as a pharmacist, pharmacy technician, pharmacy intern or pharmacy student under the Pharmacist and Pharmacy Technician Profession Regulations (*EC533/14*); and
- (b) is employed in a dispensary in a hospital or health facility operated by the Government or Health PEI,

is exempt from the prohibition of clause 86(1)(h) of the Act in respect of the dispensing or compounding of drugs performed by the person in the scope of his or her employment. (*EC754/14*)

2. Revocation

These regulation are revoked on December 31, 2018. (*EC754/14*)
