ANIMAL HEALTH ACT PREMISES IDENTIFICATION REGULATIONS

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**ANIMAL HEALTH ACT****Chapter A-11.1****PREMISES IDENTIFICATION REGULATIONS**

Pursuant to sections 2.3 and 4 of the *Animal Health Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. A-11.1, Council made the following regulations:

1. Definitions

In these regulations,

- (a) “**Act**” means the *Animal Health Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. A-11.1;
- (b) “**kept**”, with respect to an animal, includes raised or assembled;
- (c) “**premises identification number**” means a unique identifying number assigned to a premises by the Registrar under clause 6(1)(b). (*EC137/13; 181/19; 827/25*)

2. Application of regulations

These regulations apply in respect of premises of a class set out in Schedule A at which an animal is kept or disposed of. (*EC137/13; 827/25*)

3. Information to be provided by owners

- (1) The owner of a premises to which these regulations apply shall provide to the Registrar, in the form that the Registrar requests and at the times required in subsection (2), the following information:
 - (a) the parcel number of the premises and, if so required by the Registrar, the geo-referenced co-ordinates of the premises;
 - (b) the name, mailing address, email address, phone number and fax number of the owner of the premises;
 - (c) the name, mailing address, email address, phone number and fax number of an individual responsible for day-to-day operations at the premises whom the Registrar may contact respecting the premises;
 - (d) the business name in which the premises is operated;
 - (e) the class of the premises, as set out in Schedule A;
 - (f) each species of animal kept or disposed of on the premises;
 - (g) the maximum capacity for each class of animal kept or disposed of on the premises.

Times information is required

- (2) The owner of a premises to which these regulations apply shall provide to the Registrar the information required under subsection (1)
- (a) within 30 days after the latter of
 - (i) the day this regulation comes into force, and
 - (ii) the day an animal of a prescribed class is first kept or disposed of at the premises; and
 - (b) upon the request of the Registrar, without delay.

Notice of change

- (3) The owner of premises to which these regulations apply shall inform the Registrar of any change in the information previously provided by the owner to the Registrar under subsection (1), within 30 days after the change. *(EC137/13; 827/25)*

4. Information provided by organizations

Where the owner of a premises to which these regulations apply is registered with, licensed by or a member of an organization listed in Schedule B, the organization shall, on the written request of the Registrar, provide, in the form and within the time required by the Registrar, any information referred to in subsection 3(1) related to the premises, in the possession of the organization. *(EC137/13; 827/25)*

5. Identification roll

The Registrar shall establish and maintain an identification roll, which shall contain the information set out in subsection 3(1) reported to the Registrar. *(EC137/13)*

6. Duties of Registrar

- (1) Where the owner of a premises to which these regulations apply or an organization provides to the Registrar information in accordance with subsection 3(1) or section 4 respectively, the Registrar shall
- (a) record the information in the identification roll, if it has not previously been recorded there; and
 - (b) where a premises identification number has not previously been assigned to the premises,
 - (i) assign a premises identification number to the premises,
 - (ii) record the premises identification number in the identification roll, and
 - (iii) notify the owner of the premises, in writing, of the premises identification number.
- (2) Where the owner of a premises to which these regulations apply informs the Registrar, in accordance with subsection 3(3), of a change to the information previously provided to the Registrar by the owner, the Registrar shall update the information roll with the change. *(EC137/13; 827/25)*

1. Abattoir, including a poultry processing facility
2. Apiary

4. Auction or Sale Facility
5. Bee Yard
6. Competition Facility
7. Dead Stock Facility
8. Exhibition or Fair Ground
9. Farm, including a hobby farm or small acreage farm
10. Feedlot
11. Feedstore, where animals are sold or offered for sale
12. Hatchery
13. Insemination Facility
14. Pasture, including community pasture land
15. Racetrack
16. Rendering Plant
17. Research Facility
18. Stable
19. Veterinary Clinic, Hospital or Laboratory
20. Zoo, including a petting zoo
