EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS ACT CHAPTER E-6.2

EXEMPTION REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 41 of the *Employment Standards Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-6.2, Council made the following regulations:

1. Act, defined

In these regulations, "Act" means the *Employment Standards Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-6.2. (EC574/17)

2. Exemption

Athletes while engaged in activities related to their athletic endeavours are exempt from the application of sections 5, 6 to 15.1, 17 and 29 of the Act. (EC574/17)

3. Exemption – persons appointed under *Election Act*

(1) The persons listed in subsection (2) are exempt from the application of sections 6 to 10 and 16 of the Act.

Application

- (2) The exemptions specified in subsection (1) apply to
 - (a) returning officers appointed under subsection 9(1) of the *Election Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, cap. E-1.1;
 - (b) election clerks appointed under subsection 10(1) of the *Election Act*; and
 - (c) election officers appointed under subsection 14.1(1) of the *Election Act.* (EC110/23)
