CHAPTER R-10.1

REGULATED HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT

RESERVED ACTIVITIES REGULATIONS

Pursuant to subsection 96(1) of the *Regulated Health Professions Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-10.1, Council made the following regulations:

1. In these regulations, Definitions
 - (a) “Act” means the *Regulated Health Professions Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-10.1; Act
 - (b) “prescriber” means a prescriber as defined in the *Pharmacy Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-6.1. (EC536/15) prescriber
2. (1) For the purposes of section 86 of the Act, the administration of a substance prescribed by a prescriber by any of the following means is designated as a reserved activity: Designation of reserved activity
 - (a) oral, sublingual or buccal;
 - (b) topical.
- (2) For greater certainty, topical administration includes ophthalmic, otic and intranasal administration. (EC536/15) Topical administration
