**VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT**  
**CHAPTER V-3.1**  
**REGULATIONS**

---

Pursuant to section 37 of the *Victims of Crime Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. V-3.1, Council made the following regulations:

**1. Amount of surcharge**

For the purposes of subsection 9(2) of the Act, the amount of surcharge imposed under subsection 9(1) in respect of a conviction for an offence under an enactment is \$25. (EC464/19)

**2. Priority**

Money received by the appropriate court official in respect of a conviction for an offence under an enactment shall be applied in the following order:

- (a) in payment of the surcharge;
- (b) in payment of the fine. (EC464/19)

**3. Small claims**

For the purposes of subsection 15(3) of the Act, the prescribed amount of compensation in respect of small claims is \$1,000. (EC464/19)

**4. Entitlement to Compensation**

For the purposes of clause 16(1)(a) of the Act, the sections of the *Criminal Code* (Canada), set out in column 1 of the Schedule to these regulations relating to the offences described in column 2, are the prescribed sections. (EC464/19)

**5. Maximum compensation**

For the purposes of subsection 25(1) of the Act, the maximum amount of compensation that may be awarded to all applicants

- (a) in respect of the injury or death of one victim is \$15,000; and
- (b) in respect of one occurrence is \$30,000. (EC464/19)

**6. Revocation**

The *Victims of Crime Act* Regulations (566/89) are revoked. (EC464/19)
