DECISION


Background

1. On 17 March 2000, the applicant filed with the Prince Edward Island Labour Relations Board, hereinafter referred to as the "Board", an Application for Revocation of Certificate Order 7-66, issued on the 24th day of May, 1966. The ground for Revocation stated in the Applicant's affidavit at Paragraph 9 is: "That I do verily believe that the current members of the Union employed at Ford Electric Ltd do not wish to be represented for collective bargaining purposes by the Respondent Union."
2. On 14 April 2000, the Respondent filed its Reply to the Application for Revocation of Certification in Form 10. The basis for their opposition to the application is set out in Paragraph 4 which states:
 - A. *The employees of Ford Electric Ltd. want to be represented by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers for collective bargaining purposes.*
 - B. *Negotiations have been started in accordance with Section 23 of the P.E.I. Labour Act.*
3. On 04 May 2000, the Labour Relations Board received a letter from Counsel for the Applicant in which he requests a representation vote and states in paragraph 2 of his letter: "Ford Electric Ltd. is prepared to stand by the results of such a vote".


4. On 05 May 2000, the Chief Executive Officer posted notice of a representation vote to be held on 12 May 2000.

Conclusion

The results of the representation vote confirmed the two employees wish the Union to act as bargaining agent on their behalf. In light of the foregoing, the Board orders the Application for Revocation of Certification Order # 7-66 between Ford Electric Ltd. and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers - Local 1432 be dismissed.


