Re: Application for Certification

Local P282 Canadian Food and Allied Workers	APPLICANT
C. M. McLean Limited	RESPONDENT

The Application was filed with the Board on the 1st day of November, 1973, and processed in accordance with the procedures of the Board.

The Board has examined documents filed in support of the Application and has found these to be in order as required by the Regulations under the Act.

The Board is satisfied that the Applicant is a trade union as defined by the Prince Edward Island Labour Act. The Board is also satisfied that the unit applied for as described in the appendix, is appropriate for collective bargaining.

The Board has examined the letter signed by seven employees of the Maintenance Department of C. M. McLean Limited (Sherwood Plant), in which they state that they do not wish to become members of the applicant trade union. Notwithstanding the fact that this letter was received after the terminal date set by the Board for this type of intervention, and considering that these above employees were not members of the applicant trade union, the Board is satisfied that the applicant trade union had achieved the required majority position at the date of application.

Consequently, the Board will issue a certification order accordingly.
