- (3) Every person who contravenes subsection (2) is guilty of an offence offence and on summary conviction is liable to a fine of \$225.
- 2. These regulations come into force on January 14, 2006.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The amendment provides a fine amount of \$225 where a person has been found guilty of trespassing.
