

Introduction

This Prince Edward Island fishery statistical brochure is designed to present the most current information available on the fishing industry. In terms of economics the fishery ranks third in the province behind agriculture and tourism. The fishery landed weight in 2014 exceeded 112 million pounds and a landed value in excess of \$183 million. The value to the economy of the Province exceeds \$366 million. The industry employs as many as 8,500 people at peak production.

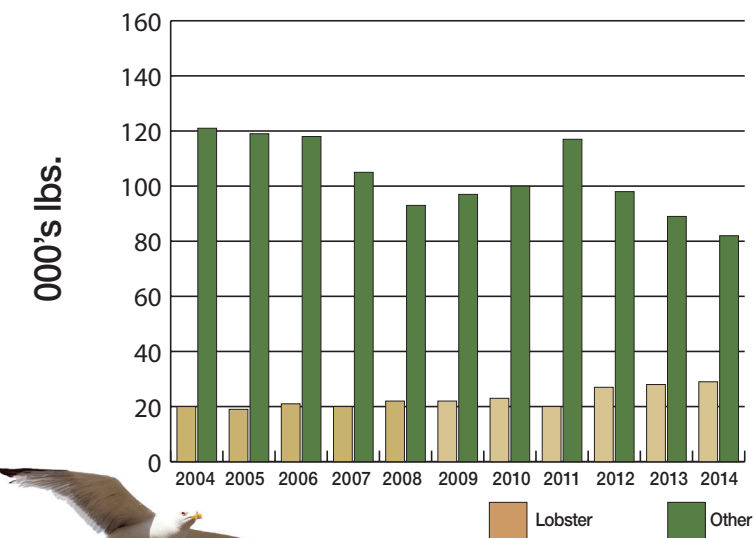

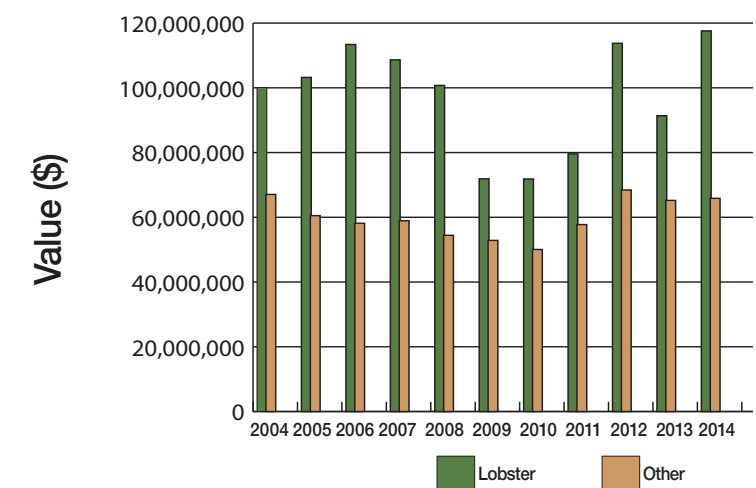

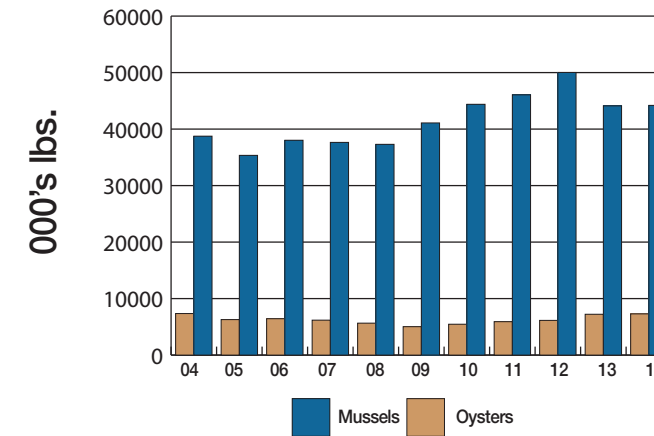

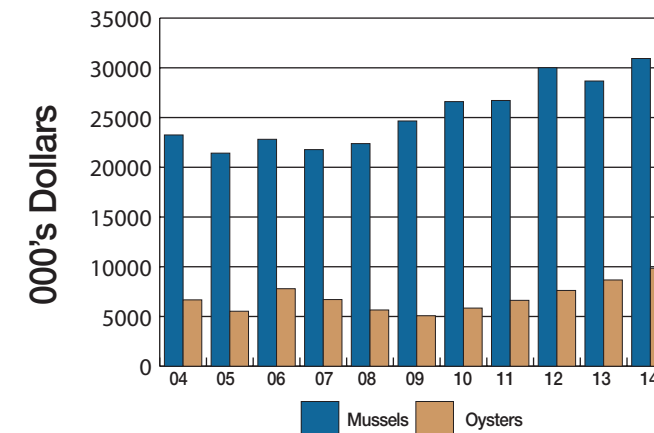

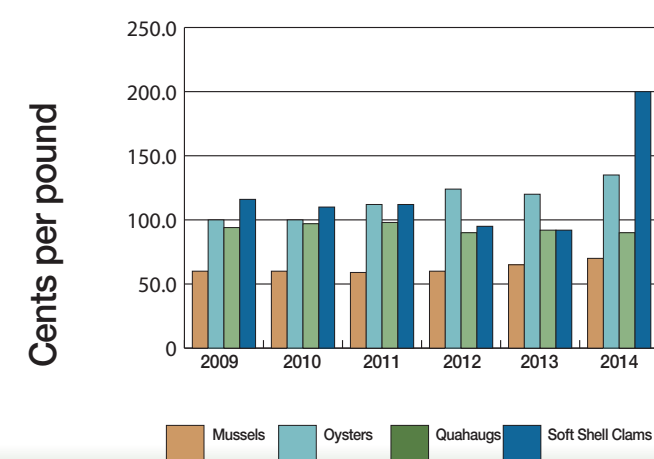
PEI Mussel and Oyster Landings 2004 to 2014



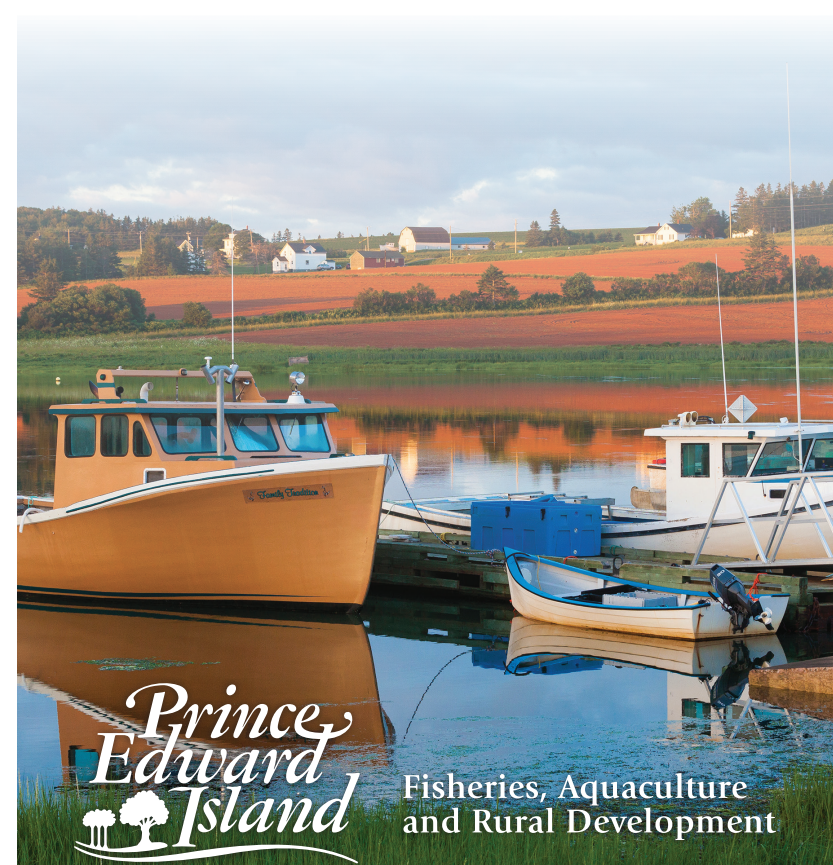
PEI Mussel and Oyster Values 2004 to 2014
