- Reduced in the use of anti-psychotics to improve quality of life for LTC resident
- Provided training/policies for patient/staff safety
- Established Patient and Family Advisory Council
- Stroke Program received Distinction status from Accreditation Canada

# Access and Coordination

- Received funding for family physicians and nurse practitioners
- Improved access mental health and addictions
- Planned for Mobile Integrated Health Unit

# Access and Coordination

- Participated in community-based programs
- Established Orthopedic Intervention Clinic
- COACH program recognized

# Innovation and Efficiency

- Implemented bed board to manage hospital beds
- Added LTC beds
- Hired new graduate RNs
- Completed tele-rounding pilot project

  - ▶ Critical shortages in nursing, other health professionals
