

Revised English 11 Pacing Guide (Sample)

- Based on a workshop model using mentor texts to teach writing components.
- Texts in each genre would be read for pleasure/understanding/analysis, and;
 - Revisited to examine writers' craft specifically (SC04)
 - Low-stakes writing (practice pieces in writers' notebooks) would be formatively assessed throughout.
- Each text type would be summatively assessed at least once.
 - Some text types may be combined (in combined assessments and in the multi-genre, for example).
- SC09 and SC010 would be assessed throughout where appropriate.

*Note: reading assessment of all types of text may be ongoing throughout the semester.

Multi-Genre: the multi-genre study may be completed at any time, typically when students have been exposed to most of the text types. The creative multi-genre collection is perhaps more appropriate as the end of the course approaches.

You may choose to incorporate all formal work into the multi-genre study and multi-genre collection
