IDENTIFICATION FOR NON-DEVELOPMENT USE  
AMENDMENT

Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5, Council amended the condition of non-development use made pursuant to section 2 of the Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95) in respect of approximately eighty-seven decimal nine nine (87.99) acres of land, being Provincial Property No. 558270 located at Belfast, Lot 58, Queens County, Prince Edward Island and currently owned by G. Visser & Sons Inc. of Orwell, Prince Edward Island.

Council noted that this amendment will enable subdivision of a parcel of land of approximately zero decimal two three (0.23) of an acre for residential use SUBJECT TO the subdivided parcel being consolidated with the adjacent Provincial Property No. 330498 concurrently at the time of subdivision. Further Council determined that following subdivision, identification for non-development use shall continue to apply to the remaining land.

This Order-in-Council comes into force on October 24, 2023.
