
The Labour Relations Board has met on August 24, 1988, to determine various matters that were raised, namely:

- (1) the issuance of a subpoena to Jordan MacAusland;
- (2) whether or not we would view the three (3) tapes with regard to this matter; and
- (3) scheduling a new date for the conclusion of this matter.

The Board has determined that the tapes of material shown to the employees of various plants are relevant and therefore orders that both parties submit the appropriate tapes immediately.

The Board also heard evidence from Mr. MacAusland indicating there might be intimidation and harrassment at the Cavendish Farms plant. Suggestions were made by counsel representing the Intervenor that Mr. MacAusland may have been threatened as a result of his appearance before this Board. In light of this, the Board has determined to exercise its discretion under the Labour Act, R.S. P.E.I. 1974, Cap. L-1, and specifically the powers vested in it under sub-section 3(9) of the Labour Act. As a result, a subpoena will issue for Jordan MacAusland to appear before this Board at its next sitting.

This Decision was made by the Labour Relations Board on August 26, 1988, issued under the hand of its Chief Executive Officer.
