BACKGROUND OF APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION

On February 15, 1993, the Construction and General Labourers Union Local 1079-A filed an Application for Certification, with the Board pursuant to the Labour Act and Regulations R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-1 (hereinafter referred to as the Labour Act).

On February 16, 1993, the Chief Executive Officer to the Board issued a Notice of Application and a Notice of Fixing Terminal Date for Monday, the 8th day of March 1993. These Notices were forwarded to the parties by way of correspondence on February 17, 1993.

The Respondent filed their reply on March 3, 1993.

A Panel of the Labour Relations Board was struck, and the Members thereon, Michele D. Sanderson as Chair; Elizabeth MacFadyen as Employee Representative and James McTague as Employer Representative met to consider the matter on March 17, 1993. Neither party requested a Hearing of the matter and therefore the Board proceeded to consider the documentation filed.


Upon review and examination of the respective documents, the Board is satisfied that:

1. The Application is a Trade Union within the definition of the Act.
2. The Applicant has the support of the majority of employees.
3. The Unit is appropriate for Collective Bargaining.

The Board hereby Orders that a Certification Order be issued in favour of the Applicant Union. The Order shall certify the Applicant as Bargaining Agent for the Employees of the Respondent described in the following Unit:

Employees employed by the Respondent, in the Province of Prince Edward Island, as Animal Control Officers, Receptionists and Animal Attendants.

This Decision was made by the Prince Edward Island Labour Relations Board on March 17, 1993, and is issued under the hand of its Chief Executive Officer.
