- 1 Data previous to 1971 see table 32-10-0277.
- 2 Beginning in 1972, Newfoundland and Labrador is included.
- 3 Less than \$500 is reported as 0.
- 4 Beginning with the 2017/2018 crop year, the monthly marketings used in the calculation of Manitoba soybean receipts are as reported by the Canadian Grain Commission.
- 5 Generally, these are programs to deal with unusual climatic and/or economic conditions in the agriculture sector. Starting in 1999, payments under the Western Grain Stabilization, Tripartite Plans and the Gross Revenue Insurance Plan are included in other payments.

- 6 As of 2012, receipts from sugar beets in Alberta are accounted for in miscellaneous crops.
- 7 Includes agricultural receipts of legal cannabis by federal licence holders.
- 8 Beginning in 2018, cash receipts for durum wheat include sales made outside of Canadian Grain Commission licensed facilities. There have been included in barley and wheat (except durum wheat) farm cash receipts since 2012.
- 9 Beginning in August 2012, changes in legislation removed the Canadian Wheat Board (CWB) as the sole buyer and seller of Western wheat and barley for export and domestic human consumption. Subsequently, the quantity of these grains marketed via pool accounts declined. Producer payments from the pool accounts in the Western provinces, are now reported in the wheat, durum or barley receipts as of August 2012. As of January 2016, producer payments from the Ontario Wheat Producers' Marketing Board are included in the Ontario wheat receipts.
- 10 Beginning with the 2015/2016 crop year, the monthly marketings used in the calculation of Ontario barley and oats receipts are as reported by the Grain Farmers of Ontario.
- 11 Preliminary farm cash receipts estimates for potatoes are unreliable pending the availability of administrative data at the end of the crop year.
- 12 Source data for the value of greenhouse vegetables, on a crop year basis, are available in table 32-10-0456.
- 13 Includes mushroom receipts.
- 14 Source data for the value of field vegetables, on a crop year basis, are available in table 32-10-0365.
- 15 The category Total fresh fruit comprises receipts from the sale of numerous fresh fruits. Apples, blueberries, grapes, strawberries and cranberries are the major sub-components of fresh fruit. As of 2018, this category replaces the sub-categories Total tree fruits and Total small fruits.
- 16 The category total tree fruits comprises receipts from the sale of numerous tree fruits. Apples is one of the components of total tree fruits. As of 2018, this sub-category has been replaced with Total fresh fruit.
- 17 Prior to 2001, receipts from grapes and blueberries were included in Other berries and grapes. The categories Other berries and grapes and Strawberries, taken together, are equal to Total small fruits.
- 18 The category total small fruits comprises receipts from the sale of numerous small fruits. Blueberries, strawberries and grapes are the major sub-components of total small fruits. Cranberries were added to this table in 2007. As of 2018, this sub-category has been replaced with Total fresh fruit.

- 19 Source data for the value of fruit, on a crop year basis, are available in table 32-10-0364.
- 20 The value of floriculture and nursery products are derived from the annualflowers. Greenhouse, Sod and Nursery Survey. As of 2016, operations which exclusively produce tree seedlings for reforestation are outside the scope of the survey. Additionally, beginning in 2016, the floriculture products category includes field-grown cut
- 21 As of August 2018, receipts for Ginseng in British Columbia are accounted for in Miscellaneous crops.
- 22 As of 2001, receipts from Wool, Pregnant mare's urine, Horses and Embryos are accounted for in Miscellaneous livestock and livestock products.
- 23 As of 1992, crop insurance payments no longer include payments under private hail insurance plans.
