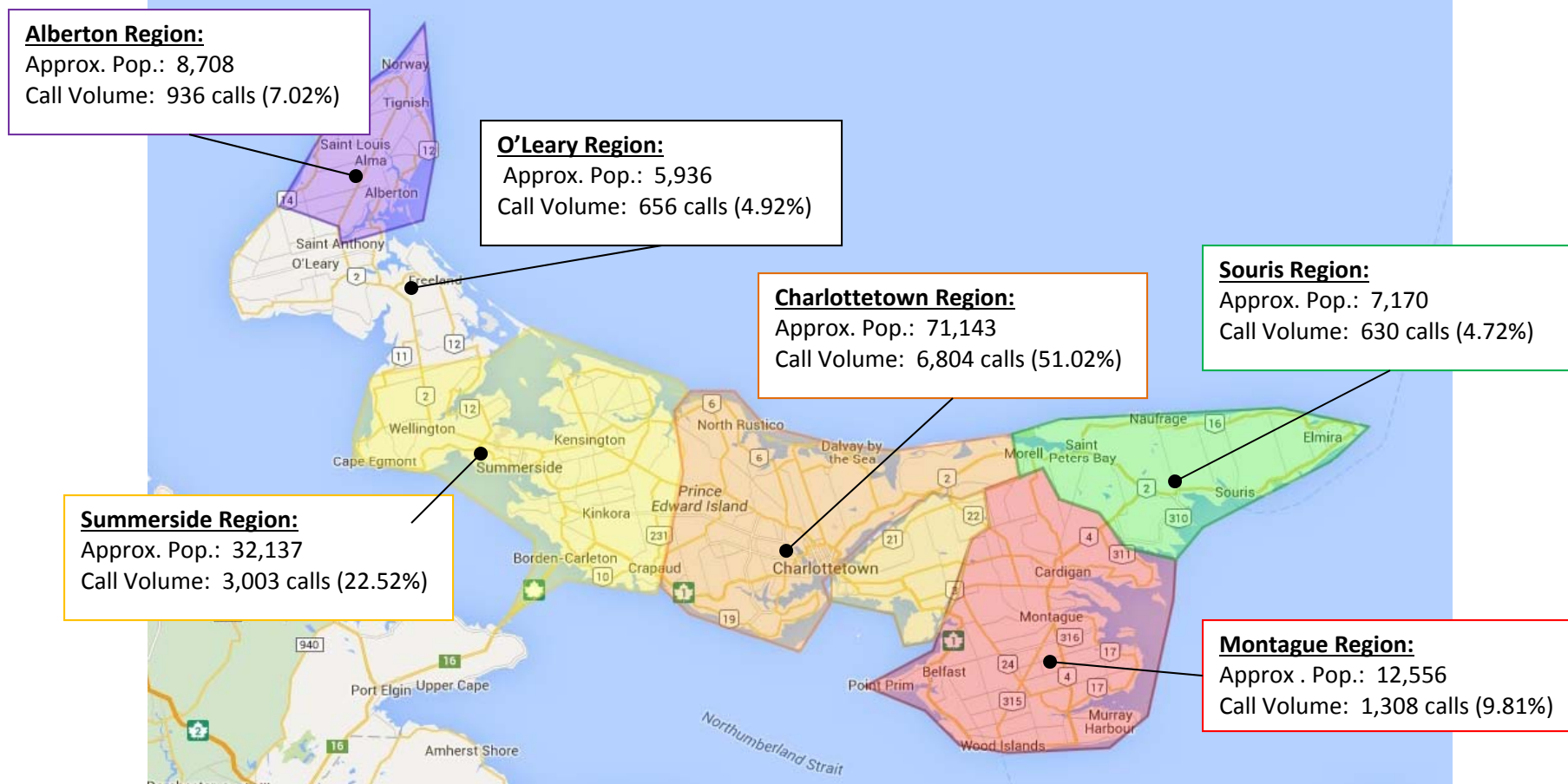


Ground Ambulance Coverage Zones
