Ms. Lewis Fleming wanted to highlight to the Board and Islanders April 21 - 27 is National Organ & Tissue Donation week. Wednesday, April 7<sup>th</sup> is Green Shirt Day in recognition of Organ & Tissue Donation. As an organization, Health PEI has not taken the viewpoint that all Islanders are donors.

#### Some highlights include:

 The new EMR system selected for Health PEI through the Request for Proposal process is being demonstrated to physicians and nurse practitioners. The goal is to have most clinicians on the EMR by 2022; this will mean a lot for continuity of care for Islanders across the system.

- The adoption of the InterRai assessment tool within Home Care. This tool will allow Home Care to use a standardized tool being used across Canada that is used to determine if clients are ready for Long Term Care. Health PEI is pleased to see the significant funding for primary care in the management plan.
- The support of both Ms. Deborah Bradley, Assistant Deputy of Health & Wellness and Dr. Kathie McNally, Chief Medical Officer was available for the Primary Care Home presentation to the South Shore Health & Wellness group to provide them with an update on the plans for primary care in their area.
- Ms. Lewis Fleming will be presenting in Tignish on the Primary Care Home later this month.
