New Positions for Educational system

\$6N

To add 100 new positions to our education system by increasing teachers, educational assistants, youth service workers, counsellors, and mental health support workers



George Coles Bursary Enhancement

\$1.25M

To increase the non-repayable bursary for Island students to \$3,000 for expenses like tuition, books, administrative fees and living expenses

Primary Caregiver Grant

\$5.2M

To provide support for families who choose to keep their loved ones at home



Supports for Seniors

\$2.2M

To expand the Seniors Independence Initiative, increase the Seniors Safe at Home and Seniors Home Repair program and double the Seniors Hearing Aid Rebate program

School Food and Breakfast Program

\$2.2M

To continue funding the pay-whatyou-can Island-wide school food lunch program, increase funding to the school breakfast program and to explore the creation of a universal breakfast program with both English and French language school boards

Childcare Infrastructure Fund

\$4.2M

Work with Federal Government to establish a \$20 Million Infrastructure Fund to provide grants to Early Learning Centres to expand and create more spaces
