NEW – Online Web Submissions – Real Estate Salesperson License

This bulletin is to provide notice of changes to the Real Estate licensing process effective *December 16*, *2022*. Applications for new and renewal of Real Estate Salesperson Licenses will now be accepted **online** through our online web submission.

*Note that this is currently only available for Real Estate Salesperson Licences, but we expect that we will be launching Real Estate Agent shortly.

How can I submit my application for Real Estate Salesperson License (both new and
