Children and youth are extremely important to the future of Prince Edward Island.

ENHANCED INVESTMENTS

Sherwood School

\$3.3M for a new total of \$22.4M

To build a new school for the residents of the Sherwood area. Planning will include design considerations to make the facility more efficient.

School Capital Repairs

\$2M for a new total of \$12M

Replace roofs, boilers, fuel tanks, windows and the many repair needs for schools across PEI.

School Buses

\$1.2M for a new total of \$16.1M

30 gasoline fuel buses in 2020-21 and tender for one electric bus as a pilot.

New Investments

School Major Capital \$20M

Planning will start in 2020-21 for Evangeline, Eliot River and Montague Consolidated schools as identified by the school boards.

PRIORITIES IDENTIFIED IN 2019-20 AND CONTINUING IN THE 2020-21 FIVE YEAR CAPITAL PLAN

Stratford School \$38M

To build a new high school for the residents of Stratford.

École-sur-Mer \$9.2M

Complete the addition of sport facility space and community enhancements.

Trades Equipment \$1.3M

Equipment and infrastructure required to deliver the trades curriculum in Island schools.

Classroom Technology \$8.9M

Replace technology such as desktops, laptops and Chromebooks, used to deliver curriculum.
