CHILDREN'S ORAL HEALTH PROGRAMS

DENTAL PREVENTATIVE SERVICES PROGRAM

Who is covered?

- Children ages 3 – 17 years

What services are covered?

Preventative dental services:

- Assessment of risk toward developing oral disease, and referral to dentist (**risk assessment is not an annual check-up**)
- Oral health education
- Topical fluoride treatment
- Dental sealants
- Cleaning of teeth

Where can my child receive the services?

- Schools
Dental Public Health provides dental preventative services once a year in many Island schools. Parent's/guardian's consent is required

How much will it cost?

- Preventative dental services provided in schools or dental public health clinics are free

DENTAL TREATMENT SERVICES PROGRAM

Who is covered?

- Children ages 3 – 17 who do not have a private dental insurance plan

What services are covered?

- Basic dental services including:
 - Annual dental checkup and x-rays
 - Restorative dental services, fillings, root canal treatment on front teeth
 - Extraction

Where can my child receive the services?

- Dental Public Health Clinics in
 - Charlottetown (902) 368-4918, or
 - Summerside (902) 888-8145
- A private dentist's office
- Call your family dentist or any PEI dentist

How much will it cost?

To receive basic dental treatment services from a dentist, **YOU MUST:**

- Sign a Declaration Form to verify your dependents have no private dental insurance; HealthPEI.ca/DentalHealth
- Register your child with a private dentist or a Dental Public Health Clinic dentist - (registration fee is \$15 per child or a maximum of \$35 per family);
- Pay 20% of the cost of your child's treatment, but if your net family income is less than \$30,000 per year, you can apply to be exempt. To apply for exemption call 1-866-368-5460 or (902) 368-5460 HealthPEI.ca/DentalHealth

IN-HOSPITAL SERVICES DENTAL PROGRAM

Who is covered?

- Children who are not covered by a private dental insurance plan and who need to be treated by a pediatric dental specialist because of medical and/or behavioral problems

What services are covered?

- CDCP covered treatment services provided in hospital

Where can my child receive the services?

- Hospital operating rooms

How much will it cost?

- The program is free to parents of children who qualify

How do I receive these services?

- Referral from a private dental office

CLEFT LIP/PALATE ORTHODONTIC PROGRAM

Who is covered?

- Children born with a cleft lip and/or palate; and
- Have an active PEI Health Card

What services are covered?

- Surgical repair of cleft lip and/or palate
- Orthodontic treatment

Where can my child receive the services?

- IWK Hospital, Halifax
- Any orthodontist's office on the Island

How much will it cost?

- Treatment at the IWK Hospital is free
- Parents/guardians pay no more than 50% of treatment provided by the orthodontist
