## PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND CARBON LEVY EXEMPTIONS ENDING

On July 1, 2023, the federal government will implement the federal backstop for carbon pricing in Prince Edward Island. Fuel sales starting on July 1, 2023 will be subject to the federal fuel charge.

Bill 5 (An Act to Amend the *Climate Leadership Act*) was introduced in the PEI Legislature on May 16, 2023. If passed, the amendments to the *Act* will halt the collection of the PEI carbon Levy on fuel sales starting July 1, 2023.

As a result, the carbon levy exemption portion of the marked fuel permit that has been issued to your operation will no longer apply as there will be no PEI carbon levy collected on fuel sales after July 1, 2023. Your existing marked fuel permit will continue to exempt you from the provincial gasoline tax on fuel purchases after July 1, 2023.

Your operation may wish to contact the federal government to see if there is any relief possible from the federal fuel charge that will be imposed on fuel sales starting on July 1, 2023.
