



Commercial Vehicle Registration Checklist

Individuals registering a commercial vehicle are required to bring the following documents and information:

<input type="checkbox"/> For vehicles that have been modified or upgraded to a higher weight rating: Motor Vehicle Inspection for modified vehicles must be dated after the modification has been carried out. The modifications must be approved by the Highway Safety Division. Required Information for all Commercial Vehicles:

- Front axle rating
- Number of axles
- Number of tires and the size of the tires
- Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR)
- Weight you wish to register based on vehicle usage
- Trailers only - spread (distance) from centre to centre of axle hub
