I/We acknowledge and agree that:

1. The property and dwelling that is the subject of this application under the **efficiencyPEI** HELP Program is registered with the Taxation and Property Records Division of the PEI Department of Finance in my/our name or if a rental property that I/We pay the total heating bills.
2. The property and dwelling that is the subject of this application under the **efficiencyPEI** HELP Program is my/our primary residence or a year round rental property and that it is not a seasonal recreational property. Dwelling must be lived in during the heating season (between November and April each year) to be eligible for the **efficiencyPEI** HELP Program.
3. The Furnace Tune-up Voucher supplied under the **efficiencyPEI** HELP Program is non-transferable and has no cash value.
4. Clients who receive the **efficiencyPEI** HELP program shall be ineligible to apply for the program again for a period of not less than 5 years for the property subject to the application.

Why Air Sealing Matters



Controlling air leakage has many benefits to you and your home:

- Saving money on heating costs
- Greater comfort with fewer cold spots and drafts
- Less moisture infiltration to home, protecting building materials from rot
- Quieter home and improved air quality by reducing the amount of noise and dust entering the house

Home Energy Low-income Program (HELP)

Low-income clients with a total household income of \$50,000 or less, are eligible to have a HELP tradesperson complete a comprehensive air-sealing (caulking, weather-stripping, sealing gaskets, etc....) free of charge.

Other features of the HELP program include:

- installation of a programmable thermostat
- a low-flow showerhead
- a voucher for a free furnace cleaning (up to \$80 value)
- a quantity of ENERGY STAR® LED light bulbs

These are simple measures that can have a big impact on the amount of heat lost in your home, saving you money.

The results will vary depending on the size of your home, the current condition of your home and the type of heating system you have—installing a programmable thermostat can save up to \$250 per year in heating costs; and sealing air leaks with caulking and weather-stripping on windows and doors, sealing electrical outlets, and weather-stripping your attic hatch can save as much as \$650 per year in heating costs.
