NEW/ENHANCED INVESTMENTS

Health Facility Capital Repairs

\$25.3M

Funding for repairs at Island healthcare facilities will see a major boost in this five-year plan. An additional \$7.8M will be allocated to repair and improve this critical infrastructure.

Healthcare Hubs

\$19.7M

Supporting the development of Healthcare Hubs in West Prince, Kings County, and Summerside areas that will provide the necessary space to allow for a renewed and strengthened community-based primary care.

Continuing Investments

Mental Health

\$145.0M

The process of replacing the Hillsborough Hospital has begun. The plan looks to modernize not only the facilities but also the delivery of mental health services. New facilities within the Mental Health Campus will include a new 8-person structured housing/day programming facility, and a new 12-person women's addiction extended care residence. Construction will commence soon on these first two facilities.

Electronic Medical Record

\$7.6M

Supporting the implementation of a computer-based patient record system that will integrate information from labs and pharmacies creating one complete record.

Hospital Equipment

\$33.1M

The Province will continue its replacement and upgrading of equipment for hospitals across Prince Edward Island to ensure modern medical care for Islanders.
