TO: All Municipal Councils

ORDER

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. M-12.1 requires municipal councils to pass various bylaws at various points in time;

AND WHEREAS the Act requires that municipal councils pass the following bylaws within twelve (12) months of the date of the coming into force of the Act:

- Procedural Bylaw (clause 86 (2) (e) of the Act)
- A bylaw for dealing with conflict of interest matters (subsection 97 (2) of the Act)
- Code of Conduct Bylaw (subsection 107 (1) of the Act)
- Records Retention and Disposal Schedule Bylaw (subsection 117 (1) of the Act)
- Access to Information and Protection of Personal Information Bylaw (subsections 147 (1) and 148 (1) of the Act).

AND WHEREAS the date of the coming into force of the Act was December 23, 2017;

AND WHEREAS it has become apparent that not all municipal councils are able to pass the bylaws listed above on or before December 23, 2018;

AND WHEREAS under subsection 8 (2) of the Act, I have the authority to make an order extending the time required to do something under this Act;

AND WHEREAS for the reason stated above, I have determined that it is necessary to give municipal councils an extension of time in which to pass the bylaws listed above;


I THEREFORE ORDER that all municipal councils shall have the time extended from twelve (12) months from the coming into force of the Act to eighteen (18) months from the coming into force of the Act to enact the following bylaws:

- Procedural Bylaw (clause 86 (2) (e) of the Act)
- Procedure Bylaw for dealing with conflict of interest matters (subsection 97 (2) of the Act)
- Code of Conduct Bylaw (subsection 107 (1) of the Act)
- Records Retention and Disposal Schedule Bylaw (subsection 117 (1) of the Act)

- Access to Information and Protection of Personal Information Bylaw (subsections 147 (1) and 148 (1) of the Act.)

AND I FURTHER THEREFORE ORDER that this order shall take effect the 1st day of December, 2018.
