INTERNATIONAL FUEL TAX AGREEMENT TAX RATE INFORMATION

MASSACHUSETTS

Effective **July 31, 2013** tax rates on **Gasoline** and **Diesel** increased.

The tax rate increased from \$0.0565 per litre to \$0.0645.

Your 3rd quarter report form will have two lines for the jurisdiction of **Massachusetts**. This means that any travel and gasoline and/or diesel purchases in that jurisdiction from **July 1 to July 30, 2013** must be recorded on the first line for Massachusetts and all calculations must be made using the rate for that period. Any travel and gasoline and/or diesel purchases from **July 31 to September 30, 2013** must be recorded on the second line for Massachusetts and all calculations must be made using the rate for that period.

Online (Fillable) IFTA Quarterly Reports

The enclosed IFTA Quarterly Report is also available online at www.taxandland.pe.ca/forms as a fillable PDF form. The fillable form will ease the burden for those who have been filling out the Quarterly Report by hand. After filling in the company information and selecting the "**Filing Quarter**" and "**Fuel Type**", the user only has to fill in the "**Total Kms**" and the "**Tax Paid Litres Purchased**" for each of the jurisdictions travelled in that quarter.
