Dear Minister Thompson:

I am pleased that you have agreed to serve Islanders as Minister of Justice and Public Safety.

Your Mandate

As the Minister of Justice and Public Safety, your overarching goal is to lead our province's efforts to strengthen the criminal and civil justice systems, and direct programming and resources to protect and uphold the safety of Island families and communities. You will ensure your departmental focus is on supporting the Speech from the Throne delivered on June 14, 2019 while delivering on priorities specific to your mandate.

I expect you to work with your colleagues and through established legislative, regulatory, and Cabinet processes to make substantive progress on the following priorities:

- Work with communities and policing agencies to ensure appropriate policing services are delivered that focus an upstream community policing approach centered on community safety and well-being;
- Review the *Emergency Measures Act* to ensure the effective and efficient delivery of services to Islanders in times of need, and help build the capacity of communities to effectively manage local emergency preparedness and planning;
- Develop a study to revise all provincial legislation and regulations to ensure language is inclusive and reflects diversity;
- Continue to work with stakeholders to ensure Islanders have access to justice through ongoing promotion and education of offered legal aid services;
- Guide amendments to relevant legislation, in collaboration with the Departments of Finance and Agriculture and Land, to better establish beneficial land ownership transparency to support efforts to strengthen overall public transparency;
- Work with your colleague the Minister of Health and Wellness, along with community and justice partners, to create a third option program for Island sexual assault survivors;
- Work with your colleague the Minister of Transportation, Infrastructure and Energy to ensure an adequate regulatory framework is in place for ride share operations which may choose to operate in our province; and
- Work with your colleague the Minister of Health and Wellness to ensure Island first responders have the resources to be prepared for, respond to, and recover from incidents they encounter in the course of their duties.


