## WINTER WARMING

Tenants and homeowners with a total household income of \$50,000 or less could be eligible for a free comprehensive air sealing service delivered by our efficiencyPEI partner service organization, Summerhill Connect.

This service can include caulking, weather-stripping, sealing gaskets, and more.

Other features of the Winter Warming program include the installation of a programmable thermostat, a low-flow shower head, a voucher for a free heating system cleaning (up to \$115 value), and a quantity of ENERGY STAR® LED light bulbs.

These simple measures can have a big impact on the amount of heat lost in your home, saving you money.

For example, installing a programmable thermostat can save up to \$250 per year in heating costs, and a comprehensive air-sealing service can save you as much as \$650 per year in heating costs.

Controlling air leakage has many benefits for you and your home, including saving money on heating costs, greater comfort with fewer cold spots and drafts, less moisture infiltration to protect building materials from rot, and a quieter home.

## FINANCING AVAILABLE

Islanders can get financing for energy efficient upgrades to their homes through the Government of Prince Edward Island.

## E-BIKE REBATE

Eligible Islanders and organizations can receive a \$500 rebate on e-Bikes (Power Assisted Bicycle). E-Bikes are a cleaner and more efficient mode of transportation when compared to single passenger vehicles. Apply online or with a participating local retailer.

## BIKE REBATE

Visit a participating local retailer to get a bicycle rebate of up to \$100. No application necessary.

## TOONIE TRANSIT

The provincial government has frozen public transit fares to ensure Islanders continue to have affordable, sustainable transportation options. With tip-to-tip bus routes running daily, affordable monthly passes, \$2 fares, and free rides for k-12 students, riding the bus offers an easy alternative to driving. Monthly transit passes are also available for \$20 for adults and \$10 for seniors and post-secondary students. These rates will remain in place until March 31, 2025.
