## For Island homes

### Subsidized home energy assessments

- \$99 plus tax for the client

### Home insulation rebates

- Starts with a home energy assessment
- Rebates on air sealing and insulation improvements and ENERGY STAR® windows and doors
- Higher rebates for low income homeowners
- Financing available to help with upfront cost

### Energy efficient equipment rebates

- Savings on ENERGY STAR certified equipment including heat pumps
- Higher rebates for low income homeowners
- Financing available to help with upfront cost
- Heat pumps must be supplied and installed by a Network of Excellence contractor

### Solar electric rebates

- \$1,000/kilowatt installed, up to 40 per cent of installed costs to a maximum of \$10,000
- \$350/kilowatt installed, up 40 per cent of installed costs to a maximum of \$10,000
- Must be installed by an approved Network of Excellence solar installer
- Financing available to help with upfront cost

### Winter Warming

- Tenants and homeowners with low-to-moderate income can access free air-sealing and selected energy efficient upgrades

## New home construction

Incentives for home builders to choose energy efficient products and building techniques such as air sealing, high R value insulation, ENERGY STAR windows and doors, and energy efficient heating equipment

- Certified Energy Advisor to review building plans before the build
- Customized recommendations to improve the energy efficiency of the design
- Rebates of up to \$5000 are available depending on the energy efficiency of the home
- New home will be assigned an EnerGuide rating that confirms the home is comfortable, efficient and saves money.

## For community organizations and businesses

Community energy solutions offers incentives for businesses/agricultural/non-profit organizations to reduce energy consumption

- Large operations may be eligible for an onsite energy manager to help them save energy
- Rebates on energy efficient lighting and equipment for businesses and community groups
- Rebates on solar electric installation

## Multi-Unit Residential Buildings

For duplexes, townhouses, and apartment buildings. Each unit must be separate and self-contained. This program allows for:

- Home Insulation Rebates
- Energy Efficient Equipment Rebates
- Winter Warming (for low income residents)
